

Make your own printable bunting

Join the Purple Tuesday celebration from the comfort of your own home on 1st November. We have created this printable bunting for you to hang in your windows to share your support for the Purple Tuesday initiative and all the commitments our participating organisations are making to improve the customer experience for disabled people.

Please ensure all children are accompanied with a responsible adult when making this bunting.

You will need

- Printer
 - String
 - Scissors
 - Hole Punch
 - Tape (optional)

Step 1:

Print the bunting page as many times as you need. We recommend printing two pages (8 pieces of bunting) for 1m of string.

Step 3:

Use a hole punch to create 2 holes at the top of each piece of bunting.

Step 5:

Tie each end of your bunting to something sturdy, such as a curtain rail, or use tape to secure each end.

Step 2:

Carefully cut along the white line to separate the bunting.

Step 4:

Thread the string through the holes you've made ensuring all bunting is facing the same way.

Step 6:

Join the celebration on 1st November and share your photos with @PurpleTuesNov using #PurpleTuesday and #IAmYourCustomer.
